

In-Place Worship Guidelines

Wearing protective face masks are optional – We will have disposable masks available. Please feel free to bring your own if you have one.

Hand sanitizer and wipes will be available throughout the church.

As you enter the church please maintain appropriate distancing from other people.

Bulletins – will be available on a table in the courtyard, spaced out so you can pick one up at a time.

Please fill out the attendance slip in the bulletin and place in the offering plate.

Offering plates will be available at the back of the sanctuary to place your offering in.

Sanctuary setting – Pews will be marked off to allow for appropriate spacing. We ask individuals and/or families to maintain 6-foot distance if you sit in the same pew. Families do not have to sit apart from one another. The courtyard area will be open for those wishing not to sit in the sanctuary and will still be able to view the service on the screen; again, please maintain appropriate distancing between others.

There will be no “Passing of the Peace” or group greeting one another during the beginning or at the end of the service.

We will not have a Children’s Message during worship.

The pew hymnals and Bibles have been removed. Please feel free to bring your own.

Following the service... remain seated. You will be dismissed one row at a time. We will dismiss people out the front of the church and out the back. Please take everything with you when you leave.

As you exist the church please maintain appropriate distancing from one another.

There will not be fellowship time following the worship.

Serving of Communion

We will be using our regular baked bread cut up into pieces.

The juice will be serviced using individual disposable mini cups.

We will have 2 stations. One at the front of the church and one at the back of the church.

Ushers will direct parishioners to which station and when to go.

We will be going to the stations from the center aisle and returning to your seat by the side aisles. Hand sanitizer will be available ahead of each communion station.

The servers will be wearing face masks and gloves.

The servers will hand each person the elements.

The parishioner can either eat the bread and drink the juice immediately or they can take them back to their pew and consume them there.

Baskets will be available for disposing of the mini-cups.

The sanctuary will be cleaned/sanitized between worship services. The remaining facilities will be cleaned /sanitized on an on going basis.

The Leadership Board will review these guidelines on a regular basis and make changes as needed to keep everyone as safe as possible.
